Desert Hot Springs has moved one step closer toward an 80,000-square-foot commercial center with medical and urgent care offices, restaurants and a coffee shop.

Tahiti Partners wants to build the site Pierson Professional Plaza southwest of Pierson Boulevard and Cholla Avenue, near the high school.

Plans were approved by the Planning Commission, 3-0, on Feb. 8.

It next moves to the City Council and could be voted on as early as April 19, according to a city manager's memo released this week.
